Information: This workshop is designed to train individuals in advanced digital skills to streamline workflow while improving accuracy utilizing the digital drawing program Procreate. This offers another option to create technically-sound drawings to be used in the field of forensic art.

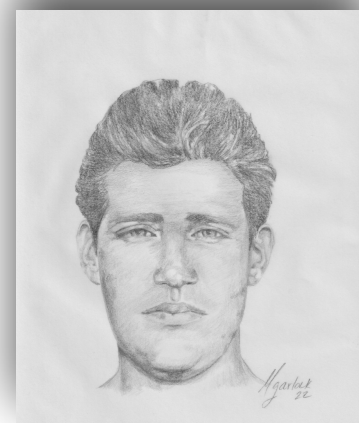
- Training includes:

- Using masking options to speed up drawings
- Creating and editing digital brushes
- Shortcuts and settings to improve workflow
- Techniques to improve digital drawing and shading
- Creating composites utilizing multiple photo references

Class size is very limited. Only a maximum of 10 participants may attend. Students will have a dedicated instructor for this class (see below.)

Participants must bring their own iPad with the Procreate app uploaded and an Apple Pencil. Complete list of requirements and supplies attached.

- Procreate program downloaded on your iPad (found in the App Store).
- Upon enrollment and payment, participants will be given a web page with the downloads on it.
